### **Commitment** – Being in band is a family commitment!

Each student has shown a desire to play an instrument, now YOU as parents, have to work with me to help them progress properly. We must support and teach them self-discipline, pride, self-esteem, responsibility, the will to learn, and the drive to always want to do their best! You can start now by taking them to the Detroit Jazz Festival at Hart Plaza in Detroit or Arts, Beats and Eats in Pontiac during the Labor Day weekend. Remember – keep musical variety in their lives!

Note: All students joining band have to make a one-year commitment, meaning that each player must stay in band for one full year before switching to a different instrument or dropping band.

In order to develop the ability on an instrument, we have to remember an important fact; playing an instrument is: 10% talent 90% EFFORT!

**Teamwork** – learning to work and perform with others towards a common goal: creating music. Over the years of playing, I hope this will help develop a fine appreciation for quality music, which should last a lifetime!
